

## CHAPTER A-2

### INSTALLATION DESIGN GUIDES

1. Background and Purpose. Installation design guides have been developed by the majority of the Military installations with Savannah Districts area of responsibility. These guides provide instructions relative to specific requirements of that installation. They are to be used in conjunction with the Design Manual for Military Construction and applicable Corps of Engineers criteria.

2. Applicability. This policy is applicable to all Savannah District Engineering Division elements.

3. Procedures.

a. A-E Designs.

The installation design guide is to be part of the AE's design contract for all military projects and is intended to inform, instruct and guide the architect-engineer firm. Installation guides are intended to complement Savannah District's Design Manual for Military Construction and are to be complied with unless specifically exempted.

b. In-house Designs.

Installation design guides are to be used in conjunction with the Design Manual for Military construction on all in-house projects.

4. Responsibilities.

The Project Engineering Section is responsible for maintaining a current copy of the installation design guide for each of the installation within Savannah Districts area of responsibility.
